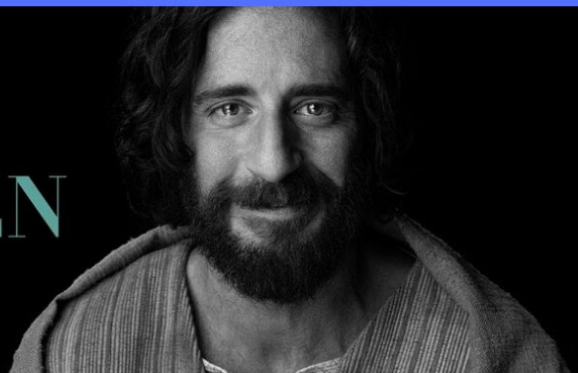
The senior citizens use our church for their meetings. To thank us, they are hosting a potluck luncheon following worship. You do not need to bring anything other than your appetite!
