# HOW TO WATER YOUR YARD IN COLORADO

WHEN IT COMES TO WATERING YOUR YARD, DO YOU JUST SET YOUR SPRINKLERS AND FORGET THEM? IN AN ARID STATE LIKE COLORADO, IT'S IMPORTANT TO WATER YOUR YARD THE RIGHT WAY TO CONSERVE OUR PRECIOUS WATER RESOURCES AND PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT. HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP...

Is rain forecasted?

Turn off your sprinklers or install a rain sensor. Let Mother Nature do the watering for you.

Water before dawn or after dusk to...  
reduce water loss from wind and evaporation.

Check utility website for water use guidelines and rules.

Have brown or yellow spots?

Check sprinklers monthly for leaks and overspray.

Water using the "cycle & soak" method.

Break up your total watering time into three shorter intervals spaced 45-60 minutes apart.

Adjust misdirected sprinkler heads and replace broken sprinklers immediately.

Hand-water them rather than overwatering the rest of your landscape.
