PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

May 2024

It has been quiet, for several months, regarding the City's attempt to change all retiree's health insurance benefits to one Medicare Advantage Plan. Although seemingly quiet, the City has appealed the lower court ruling to the Appellate Division, First Department of the Supreme Court of New York State. The City and the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees argued their position before the Appellate Division on March 21, 2024. The court should provide a decision sometime before the summer. It is almost guaranteed that a decision either way will elicit additional litigation costing a substantial amount of money.

I request that each of you send a contribution to the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees at your earliest convenience. This will help with the legal expenses of defending our rights to acceptable negotiated health insurance coverage. Information regarding contributions can be found on their web site @


