- Stop the Bleed officially planned for Jan. 10^{th-}.JH Live instruction at Ambulance Corps (7:30 9pm. Boys to receive Certificates of Completion. In addition, Terry H. indicated that he has contacts for further First Aid training and certificate courses if we wish to pursue.
- Activity Fees committee agreed that at least a nominal fee should be charged per scout for all troop activities with associated costs. This serves both to supplement troop finances and to act as an "RSVP" for troop activities. Activities outside of normal municipal camping that charge higher fees should have an appropriately higher per scout \$ contribution.
- Citizenship in Community- JB Most boys still need 8 hours of service at one charity. In addition, they need to watch a move where someone does something to better their community. Then they need to fill out the worksheet explaining what they learned from Alex
