



Section 6 - The Call to Be Apostles

"The central task of our mission is to make disciples, but even discipleship is only a means to the deeper aim: reconciliation in our relationship with the Father. We must acknowledge, therefore, that the heart of evangelization is relationship: our own relationship with other people."

- 1. What are some ways that you could (or already do) personally evangelize in your spheres of influence because you "genuinely believe that Jesus is the answer to the longings, ills and sufferings that you encounter in others?"

- 3. Practically assess the four steps Bishop laid out. What can these look like for you?
 - i. Pray every day.
 - ii. Invest in Christian friendship.
 - iii. Invest in relationships in your spheres of influence.
 - iv. When someone opens up to you, respond.
- 4. What are three to five things that are essential for our parish to be doing to move us from maintenance mode to mission mode leading us into holiness and mission?



Making a Difference Together...

- St. Paschal Baylon Adoration Chapel will be open during Holy Week for regular hours of adoration on Wednesday, March 27th beginning at 8:00 am continuing through Thursday, March 28th. Take advantage of this opportunity during Holy Week, or anytime, to spend an hour with Jesus. In the words of Pope Benedict XVI, "In a world where there is so much noise...there is a need for silent adoration of Jesus."
- Weekday Mass on Thursday, March 28th: The celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper will take place on March 28th, at 6:00 pm at Our Lady of the Lake. Since this liturgy is the beginning of the Paschal Triduum, there will not be weekday Mass on Thursday morning, at St. Peter's, Dauby. The Triduum begins the evening of Holy Thursday and continues through the evening of Easter Sunday. It is the sacred period of three days that traces the final days of Jesus' life, his death, and his resurrection from the dead.
- Incense for Easter Vigil: The Easter Vigil Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, March 30th at 8:30 pm, at Our Lady of the Lake. With sensitivity to the many individuals with allergies and/or asthma, the Holy Mass for Easter Vigil will not include incense. The incense can easily cause asthma attacks and breathing problems for those susceptible to strong odors. Like Christ, we want to be inclusive and appreciate your understanding
- Spring Cleaning: During the season of Lent we do some "spring cleaning" of our hearts and minds as our thoughts and actions draw us into deeper relationship with the Lord. With the vernal equinox and official arrival of spring, our thoughts may also turn to clearing out the physical clutter in our closets, attics, garages, and work spaces. Keep in mind any new or gently used items can be repurposed in gift baskets for the Our Lady of the Lake Holiday Bazaar. Items can be delivered to the Pastoral Center office during business hours. The Holiday Bazaar committee can also use wicker baskets and decorative spooled ribbon (at least 1 inch in width). The Holiday Bazaar is just six months away!!
- Contribution Envelopes for Our Lady of the Lake: Parishioners receiving quarterly packets of contribution envelopes for OLL will find a new envelope beginning in April. The third Sunday of each month will be designated with an envelope for the St. Joseph's Capital Campaign. We sincerely appreciate your continued support of the Capital Campaign for the Restoration Project. This special project will address infrastructure/facade problems for the church and school. Please note the St. Joseph Capital Campaign envelope is different from the Renovation/Building Improvement envelope (second Sunday of each month) which supports ongoing monthly maintenance of our facilities. If you are not receiving envelopes and wish to contribute to the Capital Campaign, envelopes are available in the north entry. We are very proud of the campus at Our Lady of the Lake. It is our goal to preserve and maintain our facilities for future generations of Catholics in the Chequamegon Bay area.



Reintroducing the Communion Cup

It has been a long wait to reintroduce the communion cup offering the Precious Blood of Christ to the faithful. Beginning Holy Thursday, our parish cluster will offer the Precious Blood of Christ at all weekend Masses. As we return to the Communion Cup, there are a few points to remember:

- 1. Not every parish in the diocese is ready for the return of the Communion Cup at Mass; this decision is based on many factors and health concerns that require pastoral sensitivity.
- 2. If there is a public health advisory, the Communion Cup may be discontinued, as was the case before COVID-19 during those times when the cold and flu season dramatically increased.
- 3. The Lord Jesus is equally present in both the Communion Bread and Communion Wine; therefore, it is not required that people receive both.
- 4. The decision to receive from the Communion Cup is entirely up to the individual.
- 5. The appropriate and reverent way to receive from the Communion Cup is by taking a small sip; under no circumstances is a person allowed to "dip" their host in the Communion Wine.
- 6. Those who are sick or have cold and flu symptoms are kindly requested not to receive from the Communion Cup until they are feeling better.
- 7. Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion who are not comfortable distributing the Precious Blood will need to let the Parish Office know for scheduling purposes.
- 8. After almost four years, it will take some time for all of us to readjust, but with your cooperation this transition will go smoothly and reverently.

Deacon Tim will offer a short, "refresher", training course in distributing the Precious Blood, for current Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) from all cluster parishes. The 30 minute refresher course will be offered two different times to accommodate all EMHC.

Sunday, March 17th, after the 9:00 am Mass at OLL, and again Wednesday, March 20th at 5:30 pm at OLL.


