Father Jerome's Message: "Remain in me..." John 15: 1 - 8

The whole of creation comes from God. And it belongs to Him. The Gospel shows us how everything is connected to the source and how it grows all along. Jesus chooses something very common and simple to understand, something the disciples come across in their everyday life – the vine, branches and fruits. Jesus explains to them the process of getting a good harvest. The disciples are aware of this process, and it is common – pruning, and getting rid of weaker branches. Those branches that neither produced fruit or were useful.

Here, Jesus' focus is not just limited to the vine or branches. There is a bigger scope in His mind. Jesus says, "Remain in me..." just like a branch, attached well and receiving good nourishment, it will eventually produce rich fruits. We are aware of weaker branches, our so called habits, addictions, unhealthy behaviors and temperaments – not at all good for us, and they also block healthy growth of body, mind and soul. Jesus says, "You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you." Jesus is speaking to each one of us. Do you really pay attention to Jesus' words? The key to remaining in Jesus and fostering a healthy relationship with Him is to "listen to him."

Question of the Week: *When do you recognize the nourishment and sustenance you receive from the vine? How do you refresh that connection when you feel it weakening*









He often gave so much to the poor that his brothers tried to limit his generosity. Because of his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, he is the Patron Saint of Eucharistic Congresses and Societies.

The Adoration Chapel at Our Lady of the Lake is named after St. Paschal Baylon. Adoration time is available Wednesday 8:00 am though Thursday 6:00 pm.
