By following a few simple things we can lessen the damage done.

### CHECK TIRES

Underinflated tires risk wheel damage so make sure tires are set to the proper air pressures. Find out the ideal tire pressure for your vehicle inside your driver's side door frame.

### LOOK AHEAD

Stay alert to all road conditions, avoidance is the best

### SLOW DOWN

If you are already on top of the pothole and cannot avoid it slow down before hitting it. Don't forget to let your foot off the brake before actually hitting the pothole though!

### WATCH FOR PUDDLES

Puddles on the road can actually be deep pot holes hiding under all that water!
