
ne of the most award winning wineries in Texas is located around the corner in Spring Branch. In case you missed it, Nice Winery (at the corner of Westview Drive and Lumpkin Road), won Reserve Grand Champion Best of Show in the prestigious Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo 2022 International Wine Competition. One of their bottles was auctioned off in February for \$200,000 to raise funds for college scholarships.

Nice Winery was founded over 15 years ago by Le Cordon Bleu trained Chefs and Certified Sommeliers Ryan Levy and Ian Eastveld. They now make organic and sustainably grown wine, teach wine classes, and lead culinary classes at Nice Winery's Houston headquarters for their Wine Club members. In 2019, they created and planted the first commercial winegrowing vineyard inside the city limits of Houston. Nice Winery is now home to a modern organic apiary, organic vegetable and herb gardens, and a sustainably farmed vineyard. It boasts a state of the art kitchen and production facility that has become the epicenter of wine and culinary education in Houston. Their wines have received 94 point ratings and acclaim from both Wine Enthusiast magazine and the Beverage Testing Institute. Nice Winery crafts 30 wines from sustainably farmed, family owned vineyards in Texas, California, Argentina, and Washington state. Their commitment to giving back includes serving on multiple foundation boards and raising over \$1M for local charitable causes through the winery's extensive philanthropic initiatives.

One such initiative is charity bottles, in which each bottle sold benefits a different charity. These include the Nice Rosé, which benefits The Rose via the Emma Jacobs Breast Cancer Foundation, the Nice Periwinkle Charity Wines benefitting the Periwinkle Foundation and their programming for children, teens and families that have endured cancer or a life threatening illness, and the "Ariana" Charity Wine benefitting OpHeart, an organization that helps save the lives of babies with congenital heart defects.



Ryan and Ian take community outreach and investment to a whole new level by also offering wine cruises for their wine club members. They love taking the extra time to get to know all of their supporters. Their wine cruises happen each year in the late summer or fall. This year they are going to Portugal's Douro River Valley for a week. The cruise is only 90 people, and they have just five cabins left for Oct. 22, 2022.
