During the Civil War, Ann Reeves Jarvis launched "Mother's Day Work Clubs" to teach women how to care for their children. After the war, these clubs shifted into "Mother's Friendship Clubs" and promoted peace. In the 1870s, abolitionist and suffragette Julia Ward Howe encouraged an official "Mother's Peace Day." Several others encouraged Mother's Days as well. The official credit is given to Ann Jarvis however, granddaughter to Ann Reeves Jarvis. It was through her years of dedication in lobbying newspapers and politicians and even founding the Mother's Day International Association that Woodrow Wilson eventually signed it into officiality. All fascinating history aside though, we know it is a big deal to treat mom to all that she deserves.
