

HB 942 The Shalom Act Press Conference and Passage in the NC House



On Wednesday, Rep. Paré was delighted to speak on the House floor and to the press in support of HB 942 The Shalom Act, of which she is a primary sponsor. This bill implements an objective definition of contemporary antisemitism, codifying the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) definition of antisemitism, (also adopted by 31 states and D.C.), while also protecting the right to free speech.

"We cannot address antisemitism if we cannot define it." said Paré.

In the 3 months following October 7, 2023, there has been an average of 34 antisemitic incidents per day in the US. Young people are experiencing anti-Israel protests breaking out on college campuses all over the country, and also right here in NC.

Paré continued, "While every American has the right to free speech, hate of any kind has no place in our communities. I was pleased to see this bill pass with bipartisan support today, and near unanimously."

North Carolina House Approves SHALOM Act in Bipartisan Vote

Raleigh, NC – The NC House of Representatives have approved **HB 942**, the SHALOM Act, in a bipartisan **vote of 105-4**.


NC House Speaker Tim Moore said, "Considering the recent rise of violence and hate speech toward Jewish individuals across the country, it is imperative that we recognize antisemitism when we see it. I am proud to sponsor the SHALOM Act, which provides a working definition for antisemitism, and I am encouraged by the bipartisan support the bill received today in the House."




North Carolina Federation of Republican Women Legislative Day

2024 House, Senate and Congressional District Maps




HB 898: House Redistricting Plan 2023/H898 Ed 2 (above).
