



## ***Donald M. Osugi Jr*** ***Bowling Performance - 2018***

Don is from a family that has been very active in the bowling community as well as being very accomplished bowlers. He joins his mother, Nancy Osugi, in the Hall of Fame. Nancy was inducted into the Ann Arbor Women's Hall of Fame in 1996. His sisters, Michelle and Tanya, carry high averages and both have bowled 300 games in the association.

He was a member of the Crush team that captured first place in the Arbor Valley USBC 2015 Open Annual tournament. He teamed with Donnie Odum, Jim Hickenbottom, Murvin Harris and Richard Allison in rolling a 3667 handicap score. He consistently earns top ten finishes in the association annual tournament. In 2013 he won the 600-700 Club Doubles tournament. He finished second in the 2012 Bay City Times Mixed doubles tournament. Don won the Ed Rondot's Pro Shop Firecracker Shootout in June, 2015. For those that have bowled in Ed's Shootouts you know what a grind that can be to win. Every frame counts in one game rollofs and the pressure builds as you advance.

Don has a high average of 233 bowled in the Sandy's Misfits league at Maplewood Lanes. His three (3) 800 series includes two 806 series which is his highest series. He has bowled ten (15) 300 games. At one time he was noted for bowling many 299 games before he finally got over the hump with a 300 game in 1992.
