HAROLD STANDER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Dear Parent, Association Official, or Arbor Valley USBC Youth Coach:

Attached you will find an application for a scholarship to be awarded by Arbor Valley USBC Association in the amount of \$500.00 to a young man in the Arbor Valley USBC Association.

Applicants must be graduating seniors or first-year college students with unimpaired amateur standing in all athletics. Graduating seniors must be an Arbor Valley USBC Youth certified bowler in a Arbor Valley USBC Youth certified league during the 2017/18 and 2018/19 seasons with 45 games or more each season. First-year college students must have competed for two of the three seasons 2016/17, 2017/18 and 2018/19 with 45 games or more (in two of those seasons) in the Arbor Valley USBC Youth Association. Verifiable high school games may be used in the 45 game requirement. Applications submitted as a graduating senior will be considered for the following year if not selected in the first year.

Consideration will be given for the following areas: 1. Contribution to bowling and community 2. Scholastics, 2.5 GPA or higher (for IEP student athletes the appropriate converted MHSAA GPA will be used) 3. Letters of recommendation.

The scholarship funds will be administered by the USBC SMART program. Rules and regulations of the SMART program are documented on their website <http://members.bowl.com/SMART>.

The scholarship is valid for 6 years after the recipient's high school graduation date and may be used at any accredited college, university or vocational school approved by SMART.

Recipients will be notified in May. The awards will be made at the Annual Awards Banquet of the Arbor Valley USBC Association held in June. Winners are invited and encouraged to attend.

All nomination forms must be submitted and signed by a coach or Arbor Valley USBC Youth local association official on or before the scholarship deadline of **APRIL 15th**.

In addition to the completed application, the following items must be submitted:

1. High school transcript with class rank.
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach or Arbor Valley USBC Youth association official.
