SCHEDULE (BOTH DAYS):

Trial #1: Starts at 9:00 a.m.

Trial #2: Will begin approximately 30 minutes after the end of Trial #1

but no earlier than 11:30 a.m.

DIRECTIONS, SET UP, AND PARKING:

From the south: Take Freeway 99 to Fresno. Take Freeway 41 North then the Freeway 180 exit and go east. Stay to the right and take the Freeway 168 exit. Go north on Freeway 168 to Ashlan Avenue. Take the Ashlan Avenue exit and turn right. Proceed on Ashlan to Chestnut Diagonal. Turn right on Chestnut Diagonal. Make the first left turn onto Ann. The building is a block and a half down on your right.

From the north: Take Freeway 99 to Fresno. Take the Freeway 180 exit and go east. Go past Freeway 41 and stay to the right. Take the Freeway 168 exit and proceed north to Ashlan Avenue. Take the Ashlan Avenue exit and turn right. Proceed on Ashlan to Chestnut Diagonal. Turn right on Chestnut Diagonal. Make the first left turn onto Ann. The building is a block and a half down on your right.

Parking: There is limited space in the building's parking lot. There is plenty of on street parking.

Facility: Facility is in a quiet industrial area. There is grass in front of the building for dogs. Please be courteous to neighbors and **do not use their grass**. ENTRY FORMS: All entries must use the official ASCA entry form with a <u>signed</u> agreement. Rally and Obedience have <u>separate entry forms</u> which are included in this premium for your convenience. Incorrect or missing information (including signature) will invalidate entries. <u>Please use one entry form per dog.</u>

RALLY CLASSES OFFERED: Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A **OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED:** Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice C/B/A, and Beginner Novice B/A. Group Sits and Downs to follow individual levels of classes. A, B, and C groups may be combined. **Novice Group Exercises will be held after the Novice Individual Exercises.**

WILDCARD CLASSES OFFERED: Wildcard classes will be offered for all regular Obedience classes. Dogs can enter any Wildcard class without having to complete lower level ASCA titles. For example, an AKC Utility dog with no ASCA titles doesn't have to enter the Novice class. The dog can enter the Wildcard class in Utility to practice any exercises desired. For more information on Wildcard classes, refer to section 12.5, page 61 of the ASCA Obedience Rule book.

FOOD: Light breakfast snacks and lunches will be served to exhibitors. This is an industrial area so there aren't any nearby restaurants. You may want to bring your own food and beverages if you don't want to rely on the Club's selections.

- 1. Entry must be on current entry forms which are included with this premium or can be found on the ASCA website Obedience forms (https://www.asca.org/wpcontent/uploads/2016/04/obedentryform.pdf) Rally forms (https://wwwasca.org/wpcontent/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf).
- 2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Obedience and/or Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
- 4. No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.
- 5. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
- 6. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG and keep your dog on leash when not competing.
- 7. Exhibitors, through submission of an entry, acknowledge they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense.
