

Camp Hellroaring Camp Counselor

At Camp Hellroaring, counselors have the biggest role in shaping the day camp experience for kids and making it amazing. The camp counselor is in charge of carrying out daily camp activities, student engagement, working with camp director and maintaining a superior level of safety and fun at all times. We encourage counselors to bring their own interests and talents to the job, so a sense of creativity is important. Activities include outdoor sports, arts and crafts, boating, water activities, nature activities, and games of your own invention — the wackier the better!

Camp Hellroaring is a day camp based in Whitefish Montana. Counselors must reside in the Flathead Valley and have some experience with kids. Camp counselors will be shuttling kids starting with home pick up and then to daily activities in a company van. The summer of 2024 goes from June 17th to August 24th, including one week of staff training and 9 weeks of camp. Each camp is with a different group of kids per week, ages 10 to 14. Training in June, with no camp July 4th week. Counselors responsible for a max of 12 kids per day, along with a co-counselor.

Position is hourly pay with a Monday through Thursday schedule. Camp schedule is Monday through Thursday 9am to 5pm, additional hours may be needed for prep and office communication.

- CPR certified
- Experience biking, paddleboarding and kayaking
- Local geography and animal knowledge
- Bear aware training
- Desire to create a safe, welcoming, fun space for a variety of kids
- Ability to work with co-counselor
