Applicant for the Graduate/ Continuing Education Scholarship by the Silver Bell Club Lodge 2365 of the Polish National Alliance must:

- be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- be a beneficial premium paying member in good standing of the Polish National Alliance (PNA) and Silver Bell Club.
- Applications joining PNA/Silver Bell club after January 1, 2002 in order to qualify for the scholarship must have a premium paying permanent plan of insurance, Universal Ordinary Life, Executive Life Paid up at 90, and/or single premium Whole Life. Insurance must be in place prior to and no later than time of application.
- have a high academic record supported by the official transcript. GPAs below 2.0 will not qualify
- be involved in community activities and voluntary services
- be involved in the Polish-American Community

- submit the Application and Resume providing information regarding applicant's achievements, extracurricular activities, work experience etc...
- Submit a photo or headshot photo for identification and interview purposes. Photo will not be returned and may be used by the Silver Bell Club or PNA for
- submit a typed, up to 500 words essay in which the applicant will provide information about why he/she deserves the financial support from the SBC.

Submitting the Application does not guarantee a Graduate Scholarship. Providing any false or misleading information on the application may result in permanent disqualification from participation in the SBC/PNA Graduate/ Continuing Education Scholarship Program. A recipient must remain a member for a minimum of 5 years after the last award is received. If membership is not retained all awards received must be repaid. Photos are used for interview purposes and will not be returned.
