IMPORTANT INFORMATION

10 AM Weigh-In. Judging begins at 3 PM

Competition chili is blind judged on the following criteria.
Each section following is assigned a value of 10 points. Top score would be 50 points(prejudged).

JUDGING CRITERIA

AROMA-Should smell appetizing.
CONSISTENCY-Should be a smooth combination of meat and gravy.
RED COLOR-Should look appetizing.
TASTE-Should taste good.
AFTERTASTE-Should leave a pleasant taste.

WHAT TO BRING

Basic equipment for chili cooking. Showmanship team/individuals must enter the chili cook-off competition.
Decorations, props, costumes, musical instruments, giveaways, and any other equipment or gear to be used in your theme.

COOKIN' RULES

Chili must be prepared from scratch and cooked on site.
Minimum starting meat weight is 10 pounds.
At about 2:45 PM chili staff coordinators will bring cups to your location for samples for judges.
No road-kill items.
You must be willing to taste your own chili.
Use beans at your own peril.

JUDGING

Judging is at about 3 P.M.
Based on the number of entries there will be a minimum of two judges and no more than five judges.
Tasting bowls will be sold to the public beginning around 12:30/1.
Tasting bowls will be sold for \$1.00.

SHOWMANSHIP JUDGING CRITERIA

Theme-show subject, topic or context should be original.
Costume-show costumes should promote the show theme.
Booth Setup-Show site should promote the show theme.
Action-Show should be action oriented.
Audience Appeal-Show should be entertaining to audience.
