SETTING YOUR EWES UP FOR SUCCESS



Good conception and lamb marking rates are key to a successful sheep business.

FIND OUT HOW to maximise lamb numbers by joining-in with your local LTEM group!

Being involved in a Lifetime Ewe Management course gives you the skills and support to make feeding and managing your ewes easier.

Working in groups of 5-7 farmers, which meets six times over 12-months, your facilitator, an experienced sheep consultant, will work with you to implement:

- Early weaning strategies
- Maximising weaner survival
- Preparing ewes for next year's season
- Pregnancy management across the seasons
- Supplementary feeding and fodder options
- Setting-up pastures and fodder crops for the break

The full cost of the program is \$2,200+GST. AWI provides a subsidy to eligible wool growers of \$1,077 to undertake the course, making it only \$1,123+GST per participant.

Over 3,000 Australian sheep producers have taken part in LTEM, representing 25% of the national flock. LTEM participants have increased marking rates by up to 30%, mainly through improved lamb survival and reduced ewe mortality.
