**BLM Survey** —Work has been done, billing will go out this week. BLM has asked for comments on EA. **Incident involving 9554, 9553** – Vehicles struck on June 26 while parked in PW yard. Claim has been filed. Vehicles in repair shop. Checks have been received for repairs, 9553 \$4,556.62 / 9554 \$2,321.98. Dodge is being repaired and should be back in service next week/ Chevy waiting for additional cost analysis to determine if it is fixable.
