A concise and factual abstract is required. The abstract should briefly state the purpose of the research, principal results and significant conclusions.

The title of the abstract, author(s), affiliation(s), and reference(s) should be written according to the font styles in the template.

The abstract text starts with an indent after skipping one blank line from the keywords.

The two-page abstract must be in English (12-pt, Times New Roman, single line spacing on A4 paper). It should be submitted using the MS word format, including tables, figures, and references. Tables and figures must be inserted with captions inside the space between the margins.

The figure must be of good quality; a coloured figure will be accepted. It must not extend into the margins. References should be collected at the end of the paper. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number in square brackets as in this example [1]. The initials of the author's first name and last name should be used, the year of publication in parentheses: font size 10-pt, no dot at the end.
