France imported 4 836 MT of cherries in 2000. The 2002 cherry imports reached only 4 326 MT.

In 2010 the French cherry imports reached a total of 5 267 MT while the imports of the year 2011 were 10 301 MT (95% higher than in 2010).

By the 1st of February 2012 France had only imported (January 2012) 88 MT of cherries (mostly from Chile).

By the 1st of June 2012 the French cherry imports reached 689 MT (mostly from Spain (479 MT), Chile (92 MT) and Netherlands (54 MT).

By the 1st of August 2012 (January to August) the French cherry imports reached 6 477 MT. During this whole period the cherries have been imported mostly from Spain (4 027 MT), Turkey (987 MT), Italy (401 MT) and Belgium (339 MT). During the same period France imported 144 MT of American cherries.

In 2012, the French cherry imports fell by around 24 per cent. During the same period , the cherry exports were down by 47 per cent. During the 2012 season, the largest cherry suppliers of France have been Spain (4 156 MT) and Turkey (1 094 MT).

By the 1st of June 2013 (January to June) France had imported 779 MT of cherries while she exported 210 MT.

By the end of the 2013 season France imported 6 809 MT of sweet cherries, mostly from Spain (4 118 MT), Turkey (623 MT) and Germany (496 MT).

By the 1st of June 2014 France had already exported 960 MT of sweet cherries and imported 1 289 MT, mostly from Spain (1 080 MT).
