I. Company Services

NGAA has staff who are experts in education to help support your student(s). We focus on ELA and Math and we request OST scores, MAP Scores (if applicable), and report cards. Upon arrival students will be served a meal from the Dayton Cooks. Every meal will include: protein, fruit, vegetable and starch. After dinner, students will be engaged in sixty minutes homework or academic support; twenty minutes of small group reading and forty minutes of homework assistance. We specifically provide Third Grade Guarantee OST preparation for all of our third-grade students via Lumos Learning. Lastly, students will have the opportunity to choose one art elective each quarter: dance, piano, art, or a world language. Studies have shown that engaging in fine and performing arts or learning a second language helps foster creativity and critical thinking skills. These skills are transferable to other academic subjects and have assisted in achieving higher test scores. Finally, on Fridays we will implement Character Development which to support the social and emotional learning of our students. Our program has a holistic approach and is the only program of its kind in the Dayton area to begin with grades K serviced through 12.
