BREEDER is not liable for any damages or medical costs, excepting the purchase price of the puppy. BREEDER
strongly recommends BUYER purchases Pet Health Insurance, prior to receiving PUPPY, to help cover the costs
associated with foreseen health expenses (vaccinations, neutering, spaying) and unforeseen accidents, injury,
or illness during the life time of the PUPPY.

All appropriate shots for PUPPY'S age have been given, and a record of this vaccination history is supplied.

The BUYER agrees to maintain the PUPPY'S health in good condition, and to provide yearly examinations, vaccinations, heartworm test, and any other usual procedures to assure good health.

The BREEDER has done everything possible to produce healthy, sound puppies by breeding, and raising, the puppies in the best way possible in regards to diet, exercise, socialization, and veterinary care.

There are many factors that can influence growth and development, such as diet, exercise, weight gain, etc..

The BUYER assumes the responsibility to carry on with the appropriate vaccination exercise and feeding schedule, as supplied by the BREEDER. The BREEDER can offer no further guarantees once the care of the PUPPY is no longer under their control.

The BREEDER neither makes, or implies, any warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, other than those written in this agreement including, without limitation, the warranties of merchantability and fitness. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the BREEDER and BUYER with respect to this sale.
