Project Overview

The Disabilities Management Centre, a project of Vision Health care Foundation envisions a comprehensive approach to managing Persons With Disabilities (PWDs), ranging from enhancing the level of awareness, undertaking screening programs, providing or facilitating medical/surgical treatment, provision of Rehabilitation services to improve the quality of life and the provision of support services to improve the quality of life for the residents of surrounding areas. Our estimate shows that more than 150,000 Persons With Disabilities live in the Attock district needing essential health care and rehabilitation facilities.

Project Objectives

- Establish a Disability Management Centre (DMC) with a comprehensive all-under-one-roof approach
- Provide a continuum of primary, secondary and tertiary care rehabilitation services in a phased manner for people with disabilities
- Conduct community outreach services to create awareness, screen for disabilities and establish a referral pathway with DMC and other referral services

PROGRESS REVIEW: OUR MILESTONES

1. Conceptual Phase. This involves defining and outlining the concept of the 'Disabilities Management Centre. The project concept has been formulated and shared with all executive members, partners, and potential donors.
2. Planning Phase: This phase involved conceptualizing the center, conducting feasibility studies, and creating a comprehensive rehabilitation plan. Associate and executive members collaborated closely to ensure a solid foundation for the project.
3. Funding and Resource Allocation: The team plans to secure funding through grants, donations, and partnerships with INGOs/NGOs, civil society, social and corporate sector.
4. Facility Design and Construction: once the funding is arranged, we may proceed with the architectural master plan and further plan the commissioning phase.

Vision Healthcare Foundation is registered with the Securities Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) under Section 42 of the Company Act, 2017. The key objective of the Foundation is to promote inclusion of people with disabilities in line with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), Convention on the Rights of People with Disabilities (CRPD), and Convention on the Rights of Child (UNCRC).

The Foundation aims to work with the Government, NGOs, Corporations, individual donors, and community members to establish a safe space for those who are differently abled by addressing all forms of disability (given the support and availability of resources) and create accessible services for those that need them the most.
