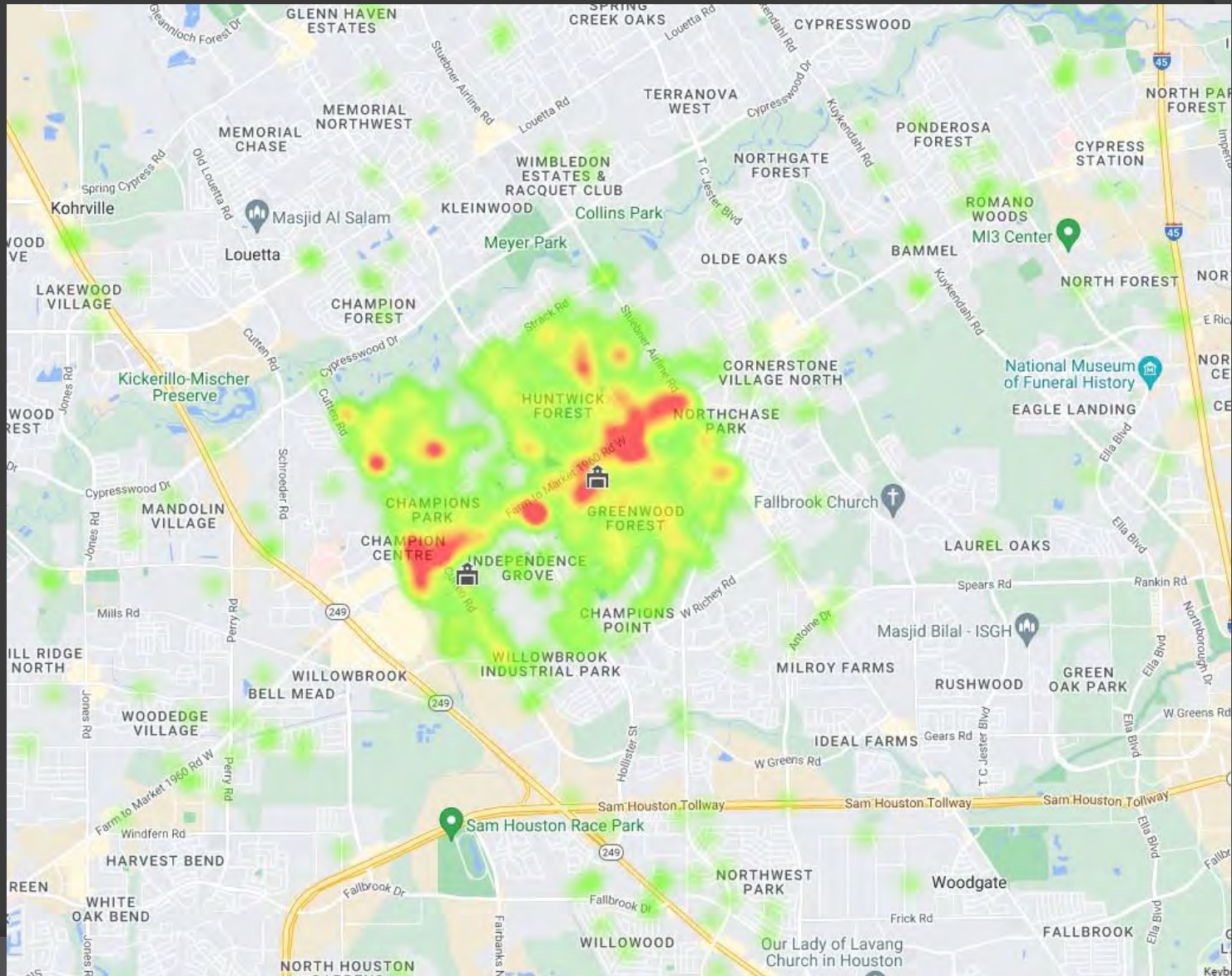

# MONTHLY CALL PROGRESSION



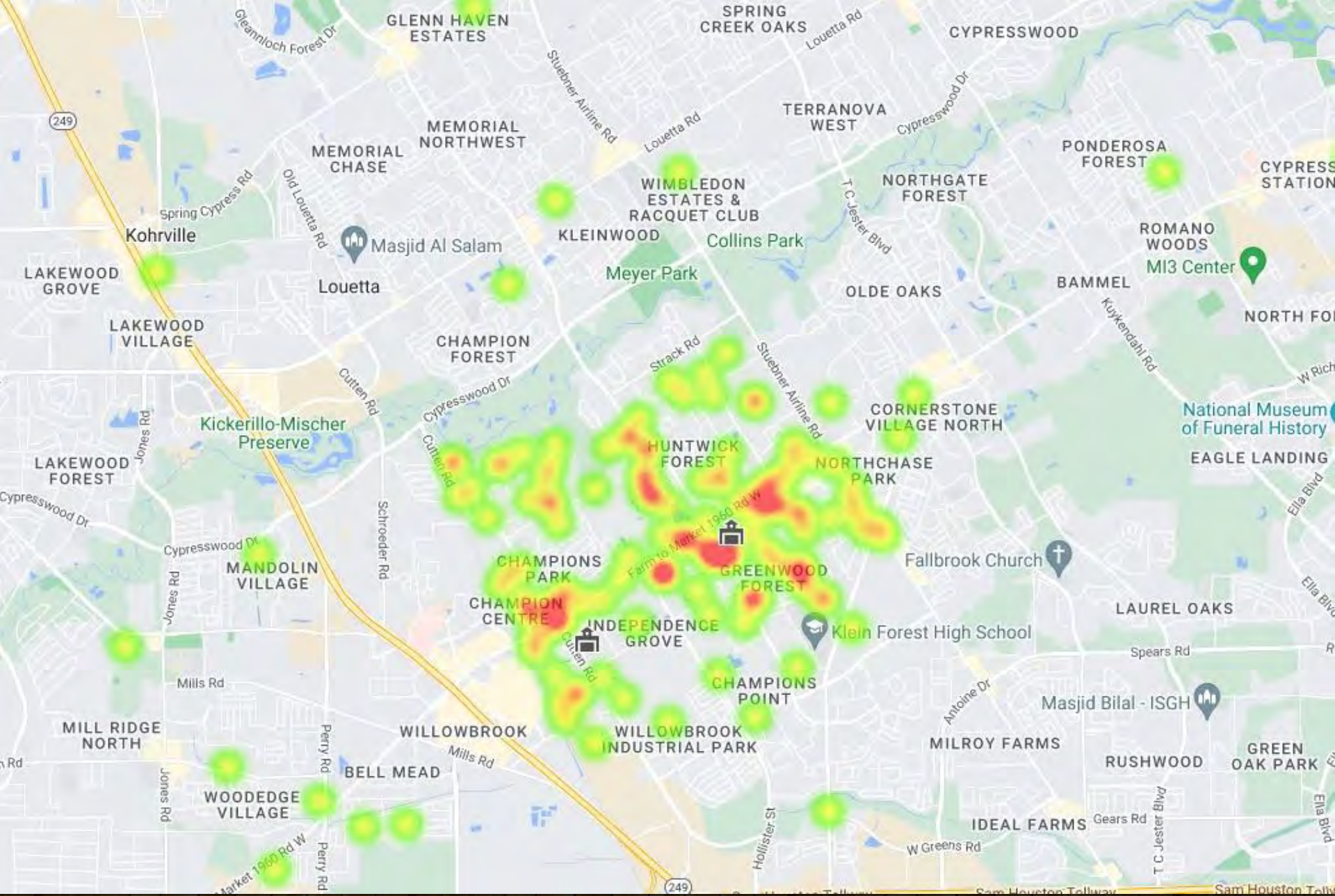

# MONTHLY CALL PROGRESSION



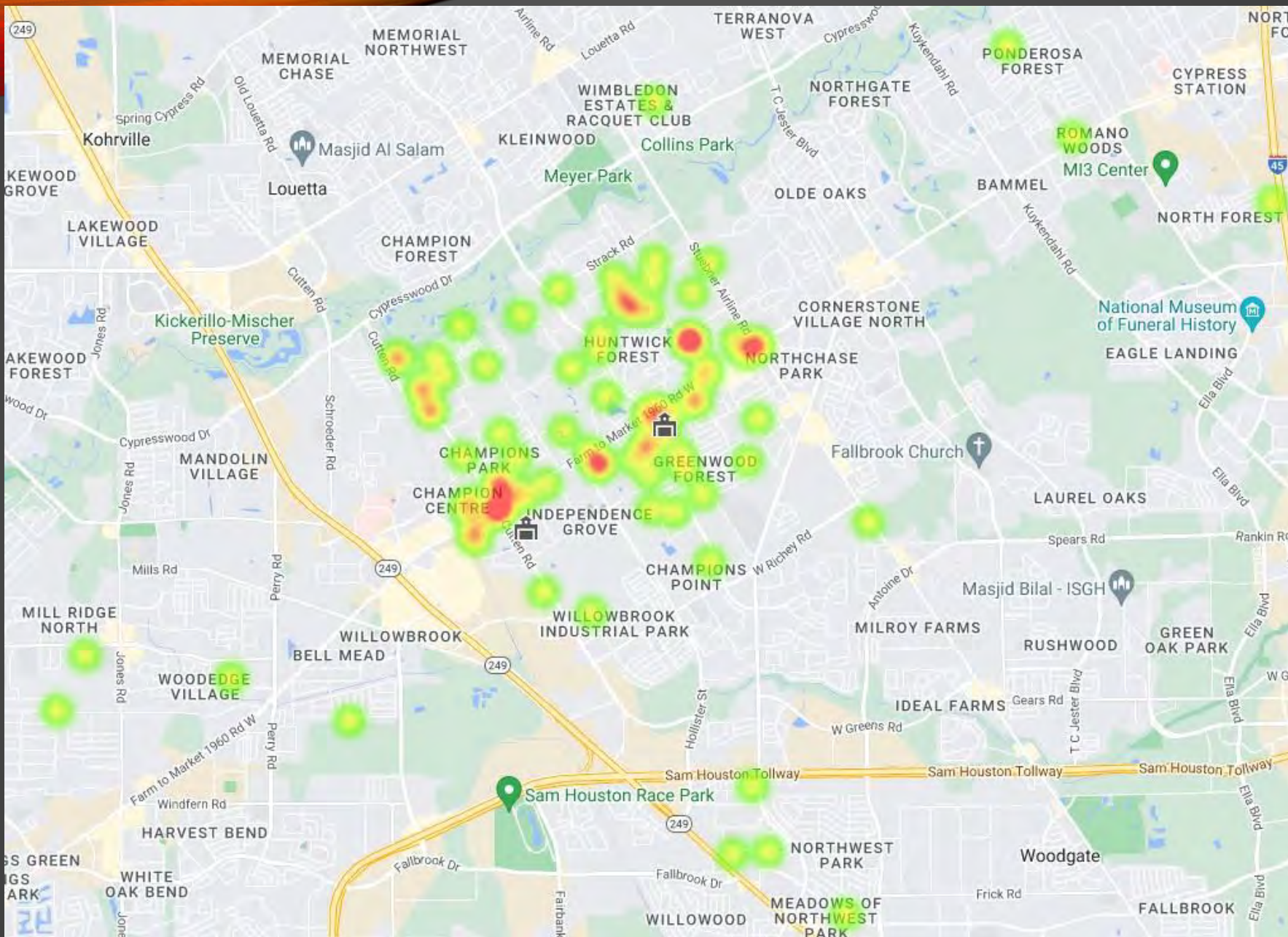
