

Siouxland Sportsmanship Scholarship

The Siouxland Officials Association (SOA) is sponsoring the Siouxland Sportsmanship Scholarships again this year for the 22nd year with over \$50,000 given away so far. This is our means of being proactive in the support of high school students that excel in great sportsmanship at their respective high schools.

The SOA is sponsoring four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors of the Class of 2024. In addition, the SOA is sponsoring one (1) Von Bornholtz Memorial Scholarships of \$1,000. Von was a long-time SOA official of football, basketball, softball, and volleyball who passed away on May 15, 2022. His wife has graciously donated money for this special scholarship in Von's name. (SOA reserves the right to the number and amounts of awards given each year.)

The criteria for the scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Must be a senior at a school district within 75-mile radius of Sioux City.
- 2. Must participate in at least one sport for at least three years of their high school career, including their senior year.
- 3. Must have a 3.00 cumulative GPA average at the time of application. (A copy of their transcripts must accompany the application.)
- 4. Participants shall exhibit outstanding character, be a total team player, demonstrate the highest level of sportsmanship during their career and serve as a role model for all students at their high school.
- 5. Must have applied at a qualified post secondary educational institution (community colleges are acceptable) for the 2024-2025 academic year. Payment will be made directly to the student and will not affect their other scholarship opportunities.
- 6. Applications must have <u>two letters of reference</u>. These reference letters can come from any coach, school administrator or faculty member. The reference letters must include information that exemplifies the qualities of the nominated student necessary to be a leader in great sportsmanship.
- 7. The student <u>must attach a 150-200 word essay</u> of their understanding of what it takes to exemplify good sportsmanship. Please try to be original and include some actions or words that demonstrate great sportsmanship.
