

Below is a beginning of declarations for those who desire to declare their marriage to Jesus by the Scriptures: The goal of being one with the Father, being Holy, having a pure Heart, being a bride, requires that we are washed and cleansed and over come. Some of those Scriptures are in this study.

*My Bridegroom, my Husband, is Jesus Christ, and He has paid the price for me by giving His life that I might be saved through Him.*

*1John 3:16* By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down [our] lives for the brethren.

*John 3:16* "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

*Hebrews 13:12* Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

*1 Cor 6:20* For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

*1 Cor 7:23* You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men

*Isaiah 61:10* I greatly rejoice in the LORD, My soul is joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks [himself] with ornaments, And as a bride adorns [herself] with her jewels

*Jeremiah 2:32* Can a virgin forget her ornaments, [Or] a bride her attire? .....*So I do not forget the ornaments and the attire He has given me.*

*Jeremiah 33:11* 'the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the LORD of hosts, For the LORD [is] good, For His mercy [endures] forever" -- [and] of those [who will] bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the LORD.

*I say: "praise the LORD of hosts, For the LORD is good, For His mercy endures forever." And I bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD, and He will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first.*

(NKJV) Matthew 25:1 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. 2 "Now five of them were wise, and five [were] foolish. 3 "Those who [were] foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, 4 "but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5 "But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. 6 "And at midnight a cry was [heard:] 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' 7 "Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. 8 "And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us [some] of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' 9 "But the wise answered, saying, '[No,] lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' 10 "And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and

the door was shut. 11 "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' 12 "But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.'

*Revelation 19:7* "Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."

*I am a virgin and am betrothed to Him. I do not slumber and sleep, but I fill my lamp with oil and make myself ready to go out to meet Him. He knows me and has taken me as a chaste Bride.*

*Ephesians 5:27* that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

*For He presents me to Himself and has cleansed me of spot, wrinkle, and blemish by His blood. I overcome by His blood, also by the Word of His witness, and the Words of my testimony, and I not love my life to the death. He makes me Holy as He is Holy.*

*Revelation 7:14* And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

*Revelation 12:11* "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

*Cor 7:34* There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world -- how she may please [her] husband.

*In this case, I am a virgin, married to Christ, caring about things of Him and that I be holy both in body and in spirit. Whether married to a man in the world or not (which would be out of obedience to my Husband), I remain a virgin and married to Christ. His House is a House of Prayer, and He called us to be priests and to be holy. This is my calling. I have been chosen for this. I am not distracted but follow my Husband should I be physically married. I walk in the Spirit and thus fulfill His law(the instructions for physical husband and wife) knowing that this is a mystery revealed.*

*1Peter 2:9* But you and I [are] a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that we may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

*He prayed that I might be One with Him, as He is One with His Father. And I am complete in Him.*

*John 17:11* "Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We [are.]

*John 17:21* "that they all may be one, as You, Father, [are] in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

*John 17:22* "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:

*2 Cor 13:9* For we are glad when we are weak and you are strong. And this also we pray, that you may be made complete.

*2Cor 13:11* Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.

*Philipp 1:6* being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete [it] until the day of Jesus Christ;

*Coloss 2:10* **and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.**

*Joel 2:16* Gather the people, Sanctify the congregation, Assemble the elders, Gather the children and nursing babes; Let the bridegroom go out from his chamber, And the bride from her dressing room.

*When my Bridegroom has gone out from His chamber then I come out of the dressing room. I go out to meet Him.*

*Matthew 25:6* "And at midnight a cry was [heard:] 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!'

*Pr 31:10-31* "I am a virtuous bride to my Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. My worth is far above rubies. The heart of Jesus, my Husband, my Father, my Lord, my Friend, safely trusts in me so His Family will have no lack of gain. I do good and not evil all the days of my life. I seek wool and flax and willingly work with my hands. Like the merchant ships, I bring food from afar. I rise while it is yet night and provide food for my Master's household, and a portion for His servants. I consider a field and buy it; from my profits I plant a vineyard. I gird myself with strength and strengthen my arms. I perceive that my merchandise is good, and my lamp does not go out by night. I stretch out my hands to the distaff, and my hand holds the spindle. I extend my hand to the poor, yes, I reach out my hands to the needy. I am not afraid of snow for my Master's household, for all in it are clothed with scarlet. I make tapestry for myself; my clothing is fine linen and purple. Jesus Christ is lifted high so all can see Him in my life, and is known in the gates, when He sits among the elders of the land. I make linen garments and sell them and supply sashes for the merchants. Strength and honor are my clothing; I will rejoice in time to come. I open my mouth with wisdom and on my tongue is the law of kindness. I watch over the ways of my Master's household, and do not eat the bread of idleness. My children rise up and call me blessed; and I am respected. I fear the Lord and receive the fruit of my hands to lay at my Master's feet. I let my own works bring praise to my Lord, Jesus Christ."

*Mt. 25:34* "Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: 35 'for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; 36 'I [was] naked and

you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.' 37 "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed [You,] or thirsty and give [You] drink? 38 'When did we see You a stranger and take [You] in, or naked and clothe [You?]' 39 'Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' 40 "And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did [it] to one of the least of these My brethren, you did [it] to Me.' *I know this is what my Husband, the King, my Lord, desires for me to do this for Him. I follow the Commandments. He gives those Commandments to all so that they, too, can be His Bride.*

*Revelation 21:2* Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. *He has adorned me and all those who are His Bride....a "holy city, the New Jerusalem"*

*Revelation 21:9* Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." *When the plagues come, I am hidden in Him and not afraid.*

And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" *Revelation 22:17* And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. *I say "Come!" to others. I belong to the Bridegroom.*

*John 3:29* "He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled.

*Romans 6:4* Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

*Romans 6:8* Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,

*Romans 6:9* knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him.

*Romans 6:11* Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

*Romans 6:23* For the wages of sin [is] death, but the gift of God [is] eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

*Romans 7:4* **Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another -- to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.**

Mark 12:29 Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God. 30 "For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels of God in heaven. 31 "But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, 32 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living."

*I am married to Him who was raised from the dead and bear fruit to God. The Spirit Who rose Christ from the dead dwells in me and I have no need of fleshly marriage or being given in marriage in the world unless it is ordained by my Husband, Jesus, to be joined in the flesh with another. Marriage is honorable to all and the marriage bed undefiled. I stay chaste and righteous, faithful and obedient and would serve a flesh husband as unto the Lord, my Master, My Husband.*

*Matthew*  
24:38 "For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark,

*Luke*  
17:27 "They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.

*Luke*  
20:34 And Jesus answered and said to them, "The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage.

*Luke*  
20:35 "But those who are counted worthy to attain that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage;

*1Cor*  
7:38 So then he who gives [her] in marriage does well, but he who does not give [her] in marriage does better.

*Hebrews*  
13:4 Marriage [is] honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

*Romans*  
6:23 For the wages of sin [is] death, but the gift of God [is] eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

And if Christ [is] in you, the body [is] dead because of sin, but the Spirit [is] life because of righteousness.

*Romans*  
8:10 *I am thankful for eternal life in Christ Jesus and for the Holy Spirit that dwells in me always guiding me to be a delight to my Husband, to bring Him Joy, and to Love Him with the Love He has put in me. I am greatly blessed because my Husband is Wonderful, Marvelous, the Prince of Peace and so much more.*

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

*Romans*  
8:11

*I encompass my Husband, Jesus, and seek to delight Him in all He gives me to do. If He should bring along side of me, someone that loves Him the way I do or more, someone who also is married to Christ, and He calls us to serve Him together and be married in the flesh, then He will reveal to us with confirmations that it is His will, and He will order our steps by the Holy Spirit. We commit to not be distracted but to walk according to the Word in all things.*
