Red Wine

Canyon Road Merlot – California, USA – 13%

£3.75 / £4.95 / £6.60 / £18.50

The Canyon Road Merlot has soft & elegant mouthfeel, it has deep flavours of rich cherries and jammy blackberries, followed by small hints of vanilla & spice.

Home Farm Shiraz – Barossa Valley, Australia – 13.5%

The Home Farm Shiraz is soft and full flavoured with dark fruit aromas and a generous palate of berries with a touch of spice. Ideal with steak or pasta dishes.

La Bonita Malbec – Mendoza, Argentina – 14%

£3.95 / £5.25 / £7.50 / £22.00

Intense violet and red colour. Aromas of red fruits with delicate touches of wood. Soft on the palate, balanced with notes of plums and cherries.

12 e Mezzo Negroamaro Del Salento – Salento, Italy – 12.5%

£27.50

To the nose, this wine presents all sorts of black cherries, plums, and mulberries. As if that wasn't already impressive, gingerbread spice, dark chocolate and oak join the mix due to the aging in small wooden barrels. Light-footed and complex, this velvety red wine presents itself on the palate. In the finish, hints of Morello cherry and blueberry show.

Ondarre Rioja Reserva – Rioja, Spain – 13.5% (ve)

£32.00

Carnforth Rioja! Produced by a co-operative winery in the heart of the most famous wine region in Spain, but whose export manager grew up in Warton! A classic Reserva Rioja oak aged for 16 months, with a great balance between soft and juicy fruit and savoury notes, with fine tannins and mellow oak character. Such a versatile food wine, this will work with hearty dishes from red meat to chicken to vegetarian or vegan.

San Silvestro Nebbiolo D'alba – Piedmont, Italy – 14% (ve)

£35.00

A 'baby barolo', this is made from the same variety (Nebbiolo) and in the same region as the famous Italian red, Barolo, but is more immediately approachable, whilst showing the same characteristics of fragrant red fruits, earthy savoury notes, robust tannins and food friendly acidity. A great combination of power and elegance. Good steak wine.

Chateau L'Estrille Capmartin Bordeaux Superieur 2014 – Bordeaux, France – 13.5% £40.00

What could be more classic than a red Bordeaux? A blend of mostly Merlot with a small percentage of Cabernet, this has some bottle age to help mellow the tannic structure, and to allow the oak to integrate with the generous dark berry fruit. Great with stews or braised meats.



White Wine

Santiano Sauvignon Blanc - Central Valle, Chile - 13%

£3.75 / £4.95 / £6.60 / £18.50

A super easy drinking Sauvignon Blanc from Chile. Light, zesty with hints of citrus fruit and a dry, crisp finish!

Yaranda Pinot Grigio – Australia – 13.5%

£3.75 / £4.95 / £6.60 / £18.50

A crisp wine with fruity aromas of citrus and apple. On the palate are hints of pear and honeydew melon with a refreshing finish.

Santiano Chardonnay – Central Valle, Chile – 14%

Fresh fruit flavours, is soft and well balanced with Long and elegant finish. It pairs tremendously well with Cod and other meaty fish.

Simonsig Chenin Blanc – Stellenbosch, South Africa – 13.5% (ve)

£29.00

A fresh and lively Chenin which has flavours of ripe apple and pear with hint of honey and a zesty acidity. A versatile food wine, especially with lightly spiced dishes and poultry.

Centopassi Giato Grillo/Catarratto – Sicily, Italy – 13% (ve)

£33.00

This white is a blend of two native Sicilian white varieties, which combines the dry, citrus and mineral notes of the Grillo with the fruitier Catarratto. A really well balanced delicious white wine which is great with seafood.

Dopff Au Moulin Riesling – Alsace, France – 13% (ve)

£39.00

Classic Alsace Riesling. Dry and fresh but also rich and creamy with citrus, floral, fruit and mineral notes with a long, persistent finish. An excellent partner to chicken or pork.

Domaine Du Colombier Chablis – Burgundy, France – 13%

£45.00

A fine Chablis with all the attributes one would expect: Dry, steely, crisp, fresh and complex, with intense citrus and crisp apple fruit and typical stony minerality. Very good with chicken, fish, goat's cheese or charcuterie.

Sparkling Wine & Rose

Italia Prosecco Brut – Veneto, Italy – 11.5% (ve)

£19.95

Pale green with lemon hues and you'll immediately notice hints of apple and peach on the nose. Light and delicate with citrus notes - this wine is dry, soft and creamy

Italia Prosecco Rose Brut – Veneto, Italy – 11% (ve)

£19.95

A gently strawberry scented Rosé with bags of fruit flavours and aromas, soft and easy with good balance.

Yellow Rock White Zinfandel California, USA – 10.5%

£3.75 / £4.95 / £6.60 / £18.50

Fresh nose of raspberry and strawberry. On the palate juicy, yet elegant and refreshingly sparkling. Aromas of strawberry, watermelon and a touch of mint.

Pinot Grigio Principato Blush – Central Valle, Chile – 12%

£3.75 / £4.95 / £6.60 / £18.50

A delicate coloured, pale salmon pink. Elegantly scented peachy, floral characters on the nose. Juicy, ripe berry fruit fill the palate with good acidity and an off dry finish.
