

# Race Communiqué #2 3 March 2023

#### **General Announcements:**

**Sign-in** at the start area. Sign-in opens an hour before and closes 10 minutes before assigned start time. Failing to sign in for the road race stage may result in fines per USAC 8A5(L).

**Riders dropping of wheels** for the support vehicles – wheels must be pre-tagged, separated front and back, and removed from wheel bags. Wheels are wheels in/wheels out. Untagged wheels will not be accepted. You need to check your wheels in with your driver when you drop them off. Support vehicles will be clearly marked for the race category they are supporting. Wheels will be accepted:

- For the morning wave from 7:00 am until 10 minutes before your start.
- For the mid-day wave from 11:10 am until 10 minutes before your start.

### **Stage 2 Information:**

- Center line rule (3B1) is in effect. Riders crossing the center line may be penalized and/or disqualified.
- Finish line: riders will have full use of the road at 200m on their finishing lap. Any rider crossing the center line before the 200m flag will be disqualified.

**Reminder**: Caravan cars need to be in staging 30 minutes before assigned start time. They are required to be labeled with "SUPPORT" on the front and back. The caravan order will be written below the label by staff. A radio will be provided. Both labels and radios are to be returned immediately after the race finish so they can be used for the next races.
