April is a curious month for Irish Americans in that it has two very significant dates within – the Easter Rising occurred in 1916, and the Republic of Ireland Act took effect in 1949. Easter Rising, April 24, 1916: amid active rebellion focused on the attainment of Irish sovereignty and self-determination, Pádraig Pearse read a proclamation declaring the establishment of a republic. The Republic of Ireland Act came into force 75 years ago on April 18: Britain acknowledged that the Republic of Ireland is not under British Rule. There is a lot of work left to do. Reunification is a slow process, but each step we take toward no longer distinguishing the northern counties (except perhaps geographically) is a good one. 26 +6 = 1.
