

To all JLM Participants:

As a requirement of the Government & Law Enforcement Day, you must attend at least one Teen Court session **prior to the day on Monday, October 15, 2018**. Teen Court is held every Tuesday from **5:15 PM until 7:15** PM on the fourth floor of the Manatee County Judicial Center in downtown Bradenton. Students need to be there before 5:15pm to check in.

The dress code for Teen Court is no shorts, tank tops, spaghetti straps or flip-flops. Jeans are okay, but they should be nice (no tears or rips). Students should dress in long slacks or skirts and a nice shirt or blouse. (Long sleeved shirts and pants might be a good idea since it can get cool inside the courtroom.)

Teen Court requires that students **sign in** when they arrive at Teen Court and that they approach Teen Court staff members about getting their attendance form signed **prior to** Teen Court beginning, rather than after Teen Court has recessed.

JLM students are seriously encouraged to participate by sitting in on the jury during the Teen Court session. Please remember, you will be in a judicial setting, so proper behavior is expected.

Parking is available in the county parking garage off of Manatee Ave. and 10th Street West, as well as other areas around the Courthouse. The Parking Police do not give parking tickets after 5:00 p.m.

In order to get credit for attending the Teen Court Session you must have this sheet signed and dated by the Teen Court Coordinator that is present on the night that you attend. **Bring the signed letter on Government & Law Enforcement Day on Monday, October 15, 2018**. The day's coordinator will collect the sheets.
