

Applicant Eligibility

To qualify for a training grant, interested applicants must:

- Be associated with or willing to complete work through Development and/or Health's grant programs in rural areas (non major metropolitan areas)
- Attend the complete training session



Lead Accreditation Training Grant Program

State agencies are collaborating to address the issue of Ohioans, especially children, being exposed to lead. **Development**, in partnership with the **Ohio Department of Health**, created the **Lead Accreditation Training Grant Program** to provide funding for lead workforce development and training activities. Through this program, the agencies hope to significantly increase the number of certified lead contractors and workers in rural Ohio counties by offering frequent, accessible, and affordable training opportunities through approved lead training providers.

Available Training Opportunities

Course offerings include initial and refresher lead training courses. The program will subsidize costs for the following trainings:

- Ohio Department of Health lead abatement contractor,
- Ohio Department of Health lead abatement workers,
- Ohio Department of Health lead risk assessor, and
- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RRP Rule) Certified Renovator
