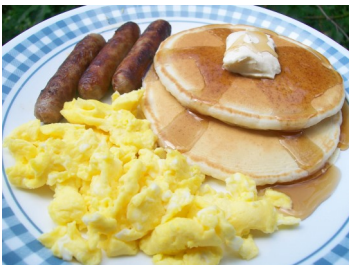

Worship during the Sundays in Lent is Holy Eucharist Rite I at 10 a.m. The feel of the service is more penitential and the language is traditional; it will take a week or two to get used to saying "and with thy Spirit," for instance. Music is guitar and/or clarinet the first and third Sundays, and organ the second and fourth.


