

CITY OF FOSTORIA – INCOME TAX OVERVIEW

<p>NEW CHANGES BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016 (13th Ohio General Assembly passed Sub HB5)</p> <p>REQUIRED to be filed along with the annual tax filing of the previous tax year.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The threshold for requiring estimated tax payments will be \$200.00 starting in tax year 2016. This is determined by amount of tax due after withholding for the municipality and credit for taxes paid to another municipality if applicable. <p>Any resident of Fostoria who is 18 years of age and older, and has earned taxable wages, is required to file a tax return with the City of Fostoria, whether there is a balance due or not. If the only wages being received throughout the tax year are non-taxable (example: retirement wages reported on a 1099-R) then the resident is not required to file every year, however, the tax office needs to be aware of this and make sure the account is coded correctly. If you are not sure about whether your wages/earnings are taxable or not, please contact the Fostoria Income Tax office at 419-435-6449 Rita at 1-800-860-7482.</p>	<p>Fostoria Tax Rate 2%</p> <p>Filing Deadline: Monday, April 15, 2024 (Postmarked with this date or dropped off at the tax office by 3:00 pm)</p> <p>If you get correspondence from the tax office or Rita and you feel you shouldn't be credited for taxes paid to another city Note: New changes effective January 1, 2018. Beginning 2018 Tax Year: No CREDIT given for taxes paid to another city. Taxpayers are still required to file the tax return on or before April 15th, 2024, even if they are unable to pay at the time of filing. Contact the income tax office to discuss payment options regarding the balance due.</p> <p>Penalty for Filing Late Forms of payment excepted Effective October 1, 2018 (per Rita): fee of 2.75% if amount paid by debit/credit card</p> <p>Online Filing Taxpayer are able to file online by visiting RITA'S website www.ritaohio.com</p> <p>Income Tax Office Hours Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday 7am to 3pm, open through the lunch hour.</p> <p>If the tax office is closed, a drop box is located outside of the water office. Entry to tax office requires being buzzed in via intercom by tax administrator. If the tax office does not answer the phone: May also call RITA at 1-800-860-7482. Please leave a message.
