










Estimated Home Values

12-Month Change in Estimated Value





Estimated Value per Square Foot













Median Listing Price vs. Listing Volume





Sales Count By Living Area




Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold








Population of Adults by Age Group












How People Get to Work


