A team of family, friends, and allies dedicated to supporting the local communities.

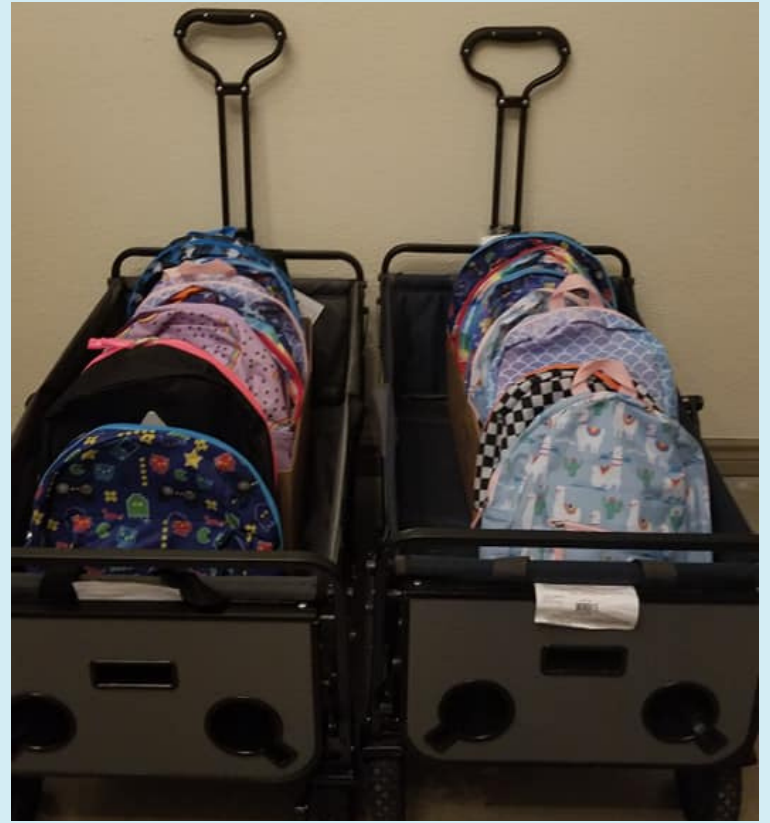

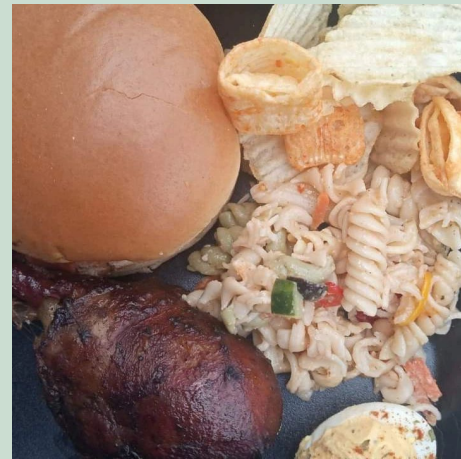

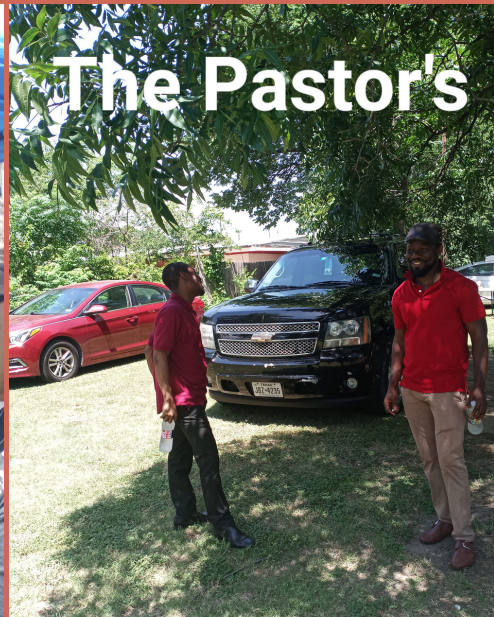
For the second year, our Ministry had the opportunity to serve the residents of Texarkana with 2C3HINC Inc and Making It Count Ministries.
