

Tennis Court Rules

These are private facilities and are for the use of Barrington Downs Residents with valid membership cards and their guests (see rules below for further explanation). Facilities are considered closed after court lights are out. Anyone violating these rules will be prosecuted for trespassing.

- 1) All players must sign in at the front gate of the pool facilities during normal hours, present validated membership card and sign in their guests. NOTE: If the pool facilities are not yet operating, the Clubhouse Manager or Trustee may randomly check for validated membership cards.
- 2) Court time is limited to 1 hour per sign in when residents are waiting to play.
- 3) Residents are allowed a maximum of two guests per card. The residents must stay onsite at courts with their guests.
- 4) Foul language, misconduct, disruptive behavior, or abuse of the facilities will result in the resident (and their guests if applicable) being ejected from courts and possible HOA action.
- 5) NO Bikes, Roller Skates, Rollerblades, or Skateboards ALLOWED.
- 6) NO fence climbing, pets, or glass items.

Basketball Court Rules

These are private facilities and are for the use of Barrington Downs Residents with valid membership cards and their guests (see rules below for further explanation). Facilities are considered closed after court lights are out. Anyone violating these rules will be prosecuted for trespassing.

- All players must sign in at the front gate of the pool facilities during normal hours, and present valid membership card and sign in their guests. NOTE: If the pool facilities are not yet operating, the Clubhouse Manager or Trustee may randomly check for validated membership cards.
- 2) Residents are allowed a maximum of two guests per card. The residents must remain onsite at courts with their guests.
- 3) Only half court basketball is allowed if any resident wishes to play outside of a "team setting".
- 4) Foul language, misconduct, disruptive behavior, or abuse of the facilities will result in the resident (and their guests if applicable) being ejected from courts and possible HOA action.
- 5) Dunking is allowed, however "hanging" from the hoops is not. This will be considered "destruction of property" and the player will be asked to leave.
- 6) NO fence climbing, pets, or glass items.

Violations

1st violation- Written Warning

2nd violation- 1 Week Card Suspension

3rd violation- 2 Weeks Card Suspension

4th violation- 3 Weeks Card Suspension
