Greetings,

This letter is to inform you that the Mu Rho and Iota Mu Mu Chapters of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. is having its annual Talent Hunt Competition. This program is one of several national programs designed to identify and support the youth of our nation and the world. The program has touched thousands of students many of whom have gone on to make outstanding contributions to their communities. It also provides exposure, encouragement, and financial assistance to talented young people participating in the performing arts. The winners are awarded recognition and scholarships. It is our quest as Omega Men of Substance to continue to grow in our unyielding commitment to support our youth.

Prizes for the winners in this competition will be awarded as follows:

First Prize - \$1,000.00 Second Prize - \$600.00 Third Prize - \$400.00

The performance competition will be held on **Saturday, March 16, 2024, from 1 pm to 4 pm** and will be located at **Georgetown East Elementary School**, 111 Dogwood Road, Annapolis, MD 21403.

This year's competition will include vocal and instrumental music, dance, dramatic interpretation, and visual arts. **Participants must be high school students in grades 9-12** competing in the below-listed forms of talent.

Vocal Music: Classical, contemporary, gospel, and jazz entries are welcomed (No Rap Music). For classical renditions, a printed copy of the music (score) is required for the judges to analyze. Contestants can bring their accompanist as a piano will be provided. An accompanist will be provided if the contestant does not have one and if he/she brings all sheet music for the songs being performed. Recorded instrumental music tracks may be used for vocal accompaniment, but these tracks may not contain lead or background vocals.

- 2. **Instrumental Music**: Classical, contemporary, gospel, and jazz entries are welcomed. For classical renditions, a printed copy of the music (score) is required for the judges to analyze. Contestants can bring their accompanist as a piano will be provided. An accompanist will be provided if the contestant does not have one and if he/she brings all sheet music for the songs being performed.
- 3. **Dance:** Ballet, modern dance, and tap. Attire for performance is acceptable to wear for the event.
- 4. **Dramatic Interpretation:** Poetry, oration, monologue, etc. A printed script must be provided for each judge.
- 5. **Visual Art:** Sculpture, photography, drawing, and painting. Three (3) to five (5) pieces for judging must be provided. All easels and display board lights are to be provided by the contestant.

The winner of this Talent Hunt competition **MUST** participate in the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. 2nd District Talent Hunt competition which will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024. Prize money will be awarded to the **First Place Winner** of the chapter competition **ONLY** after attending and participating in the District Competition. Details for the district event will be provided.

All Talent Hunt participant **applications must** be received no later than Friday, **February 29**, **2024**. Registration forms must be complete and contain sufficient details to allow evaluation of eligibility for participation in the program and technical requirements. A completed Omega Psi Phi Parental Release & Consent Form must also be turned in with the contestant's application. Both forms have been included in this communication. Talent Hunt Participation Eligibility Requirements

A. Participation in the Talent Hunt is open for the following form of trained art:

 Ω **Music**: Vocal and instrumental; classical, semi-classical, gospel and jazz. *A printed copy of the music (score) is required for the judges to analyze.*

B. Basic Rules for Participation in the District and International Talent Hunt:

- Ω Contestant must be a high school student who has not advanced beyond a senior year at time of the Local Talent Hunt.
- Ω Contestants who are "**Home Schooled**" must present verification from their school district that they are enrolled as a high school student.
- Ω All applicants for the Talent Hunt are to include SAT scores or ACT scores when available as well as their grade point averages.
- Ω All presentations including instrumental numbers must be memorized and must be dignified and in good taste. Presentations which are not memorized cannot be considered for 1st place.
- Ω Track music may be used for accompaniment as long as there is no lead instrumental or background vocals included on the track.
- Ω The Talent Hunt is a competition on the Chapter, State, and District levels.
- Ω The International Talent Hunt is a Demonstration only! There is no adjudication at this level.
- Ω The presentation performed or presented at the Chapter level shall be the same as performed at the State, District, and international level.
- Ω The Chapter is responsible for all expenses incurred in taking its contestant to the State and District Talent Hunt.
- Ω Where there is a state competition, the State is responsible for all expenses incurred in taking its contestant to the State Talent Hunt.
- Ω The district is responsible for expenses incurred in taking the District Winner to the International Talent Hunt Demonstration and the Grand Conclave.
