Letter from the Ministry Team:

Join Us in Celebrating our Music Team Sunday, May 19, 10AM

At a recent Ministry Team meeting, members discussed our regular Sunday worship as, like many other churches, we have experienced a decline in attendance that has not recovered since Covid first affected attendance. Many of those who have not returned to Sunday worship are families with children and they are truly missed. However, we feel that our church is "alive" and doing God's work in many wonderful ways. We truly look forward to the time when our pews will again be filled each Sunday. If you haven't attended for a while, we want to let you know about some of our activities.

Since the beginning of 2024, we have served our community and our world in many ways and share a few examples here:

Members donated \$2,290 for UMCOR;

During the Lenten season, we provided more than 100 cans of food, 122 rolls of toilet tissue, 152 packages of diapers and 80 pounds of hygiene products toTualatin Schoolhouse Pantry; Individuals have furnished food twice for families residing at Family Promise "Bridge to Home" and, on two occasions, a team of 3 or 4 individuals from our congregation have worked in their food pantry to fill orders;

Adorned the sanctuary Easter Sunday with flowers purchased in honor or of loved ones.

We have a fantastic group of musicians who fill our souls each and every Sunday. Hal Filiar-Aguilera is our Praise Team Director and has blessed us with some songs which he has written. Our very talented pianist, Devin Tran, is 15 years old and, on occasion, has played his saxophone for the prelude. (You really won't believe his talent until you experience it for yourself.) Kelly Myers is now directing our bell choir as well as singing and sometimes subbing as pianist. James Wescott plays guitar and joins our other singers – Melinda Beyers, Rachel Elliot, and Selinda Smith.

We will be honoring these fantastic individuals at a special coffee hour on Music Appreciation Sunday scheduled for May 19. We encourage you to join us for that occasion. Come, make yourself at "home", visit with friends, be blessed by our worship service.



<u>UMC General Conference 2020/2024</u> April 23 - May 3, 2024 Charlotte, North Carolina

Typically every 4 years over 850 delegates representing United Methodists around the world gather for two weeks of worship, celebrations and legislation that will guide our denomination. Anyone can submit a petition about any topic and committees discuss each before recommending next steps.

To learn more about this process, here are three resources. The first is a short video on Facebook. The second shows who is representing churches in our region and the third is a general resource explaining what's happening and how to "tune in" for daily reports (or watch it live streamed). Don't be misled if you see 2020 as the date. This 2024 conference is handling what should have occurred in 2020 but was postponed due to Covid 19.
