David Donald began his training in Hapkido and later in Kun Khmer/Muay Thai under Grandmaster Bunsong Seng in 1992, after his Honorable Discharge from the United States Marine Corps. In 1997 while his Hapkido teacher was back in his home country of Cambodia revitalizing the Khmer art of Bokator Mr. Donald began training in Kosho Shorei Ryu Kempo under Michael C. Brown, Shihan. In 2003 Mr. Donald was awarded his 3rd Dan by Grandmaster Seng. Both of Mr. Donald's teachers relocated out of state in the early 2000's, at which time he began training in Traditional Wing Chun Kung Fu under Sifu Ariel T. Wesley. Mr. Donald also taught a very successful after school program at Huge Cole Elementary School in Warren, R.I. during the 2007-2008 school year.

In 2009, after relocating to the Tampa Bay Area of Florida, Mr. Donald began training Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu under Shidoshi Robert Broe, and later Shidoshi Tom Dampman as well. In 2014 Mr. Donald joined the Shuri -Te Bujutsu Kai and began attending training events with Kyoshi Troy J. Price. In 2015 Mr. Donald reconnected with Bruce Juchnick, Hanshi (Michael C. Brown's teacher) head of the Sei Kosho Shorei Kai International. In 2017 Mr. Donald was awarded his Shodan in Kosho Shorei Ryu Kempo and was given the position of State Representative (Florida) by Bruce Juchnick, Hanshi of the Sei Kosho Shorei Kai.

In 2018 Mr. Donald was promoted to 4th Dan in Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu by Shidoshi Robert Broe, and received his official rank certificate from Bujinkan Hombu Dojo the following year. Also in 2018 Mr. Donald was awarded the title of Renshi by Kyoshi Troy J. Price, Director of the Shuri-Te Bujutsu Kai. In 2019 before relocating back to his home state of Rhode Island, Mr. Donald passed his personal trainer exam and became an A.C.E. Fitness Certified Personal Trainer.

In 2019 Mr. Donald relocated back to Rhode Island and resumed his Hapkido training with Grand Master Seng. Mr. Donald opened Rhode Island Martial Arts Academy, where he began providing private instruction. In October of 2021 Mr. Donald had the great fortune of teaching at the 2021 Shuri-Te Martial Arts International Conference. In 2022 Mr. Donald resumed his Bujinkan Budo Taijutsu studies under John Myles, Shihan. Mr. Donald currently studies Kun Khmer with Kru Jayaboa Thangkeo and Kru Kimsong Seng, son of Grandmaster Bunsong Seng, at Rogue Island Combat, Warwick, Rhode Island.
