Early & Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT)

• Is a service for individuals between 0-21 years of age. Only in combination with Children's Choice. Children's Choice Waiver (CCW) is a Medicaid Home and Community Based Service Program that offers supplemental support to children with developmental disabilities who are currently living at home or who will be leaving a foster care/institution to return home.

New Opportunities Waiver (NOW)

• Provides case management, family support, and training for individuals who are ages 3 and older and who are MR/DD.

Community Choices Waiver (CCW)

• Provides case management, family support, and training, and environmental accessibility for the home or community to elderly or disabled adults.



Long-Term Personal Care Services (LT-PCS)

Provide regular support for unspecified activities of daily living for individuals.

Supervised Independent Living (SIL)
