## FCARES Go-Kit Checklist

When responding to an emergency event, or a training exercise, there is a minimum set of equipment and personal gear you should bring with you. This is for a 2-hour deployment. Basic items include:
$\square$ 2-meter/70 cm hand-held dual-band radio with user manual
$\square$ 2-meter/70 cm mag-mount antenna with coax and/or J-pole or roll-up antenna
$\square$ Earbud or headphone
$\square$ Pens, pencils, paper and ICS forms.
$\square$ Clipboard
$\square$ ARES ID card, FCC license, other important IDs
$\square$ Extra batteries
$\square$ Appropriate clothing for the event and safety vest
$\square$ Water
$\square$ Phone lists and contact information
$\square$ Cell phone
$\square$ Maps of the area
$\square$ County Band Plan and frequency information
These items should be kept in a "Go-Kit" bag.

## Extended (12-24 hour) Go-Kit Checklist

## Radio and operating supplies

$\square$ Extra radios and batteries
$\square$ Patch cords/Pigtail
$\square$ Coax adapter - connect HT to coax and coax to antenna jack
$\square$ Extra coax cable
$\square$ Power cord adapters to connect HT to power poles, cigarette lighter socket, vehicle battery terminal
$\square$ Portable charger to charge your radios, batteries, phone etc.
$\square$ Message forms - ICS 213, ICS 214, ICS 309 and logbook

## Personal Needs

$\square$ Personal items - Prescriptions, pain meds, hand sanitizer, eyeglasses, hearing aid batteries etc.
$\square$ Safety gear - vest, whistle, sunglasses, sunscreen, mask, safety glasses, mask-N95 etc.
$\square$ Flashlight with extra batteries
$\square$ Alarm clock
$\square$ Food (snacks, MREs, bars)
$\square$ First aid kit
$\square$ Tools - Electrical, gaffers and duct tape, zip ties, utility knife, multi-tool, zip top bags
$\square$ Rain gear, jacket, hat, sturdy shoes,
$\square$ Money

## Add-on Kit for Extended Deployment (72 Hours)

$\square$ 3-day change of appropriate clothes
$\square$ 3-day supply of water and food
$\square$ Extra pens and pencils and supplies
$\square$ Extra Batteries, lighting, power source
$\square$ Shelter (tent, sleeping bag, pad)
$\square$ Portable stove; mess kit with cleaning kit (if applicable) and waterproof matches
$\square$ Toiletries - Soap, toilet paper, towel, toothbrush, toothpaste, throat lozenge etc.
