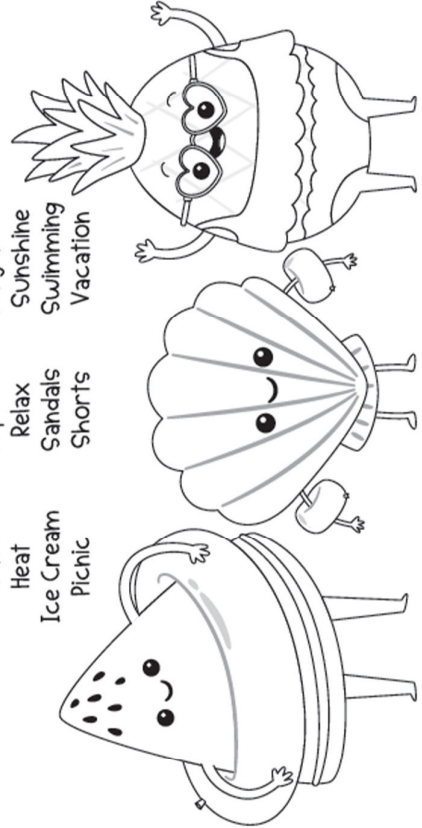

for our sixth year June 24, 2023.

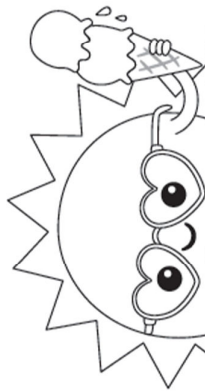

MINUTES WITH THE MAYOR

Hello, Everyone,

The month of June is rapidly winding down and I'm happy to see the first day of summer has arrived As always, as the temperature rises and days become warmer, please remember to keep yourself and your pets hydrated and check on your neighbors, especially our senior citizens.

Thank you for keeping your yards mowed and please remember to keep sidewalks and roadways in front of your homes clear of grass clippings that can cause a slipping hazard to motorcycles, cyclists and joggers/walkers. Please continue to use the yard waste dumpster across from Town Hall responsibly and that includes not dumping invasive species that include blackberry vines and tansy. Thank you!

The Spring Cleanup event was a success, thank you to everyone that participated.

Congratulations to water/sewer superintendent, Ryan Webster, in passing and earning the State of WA Department of Ecology Certification group II wastewater treatment operator certification.

We have received 09 funding from the Economic Alliance to re-do our Chehalis River intake as a back-up in the event of a Lester Creek failure. In addition, we've also gotten funding for construction of a walkway up to the dam. The wastewater CDBG grant is ready to commence.

During a previous Council meeting, councilors approved unanimously to accept a dump truck load of compost from Lewis County from the Centralia Wastewater plant for citizen use in lawns and flower beds only. Please note: this is not for use in vegetable gardens. Will make further information known when available. *Update; we are still waiting for this delivery.

The new sidewalk project from Town Hall over to the Stowe Creek Bridge will begin this summer. Police vehicles are on duty patrolling in and around the community. If you have an emergency, continue calling 911 for assistance. For non-emergency issues, call dispatch at 360-740-1105.
