Hello friends and neighbors and all fans of Pe Ell 4th of July! The parade is on it's 30th year!

The Parade will start at 12:00PM on Tuesday, the 4th of July!

For parade participants the registration booth will be located at the Willapa Hills Trail Head Park, you can start your check-in at 10am.

Main St. will be **CLOSED** from 10a-2p for the parade. Please seek alternate routes.

Do not go through **ROAD CLOSED** signs,
there will be parade spectators and children crossing the roads.

The parade route will begin at the flashing light on the south side of town on Main St. and proceed east through town, ending at E. Pe Ell Ave. with a right turn to conclude the parade.

Parade participants will be briefly stopped and their entry judged in front of the town gazebo in Tank Park.

Trophies will be available for pick-up at the registration booth after the parade concludes.

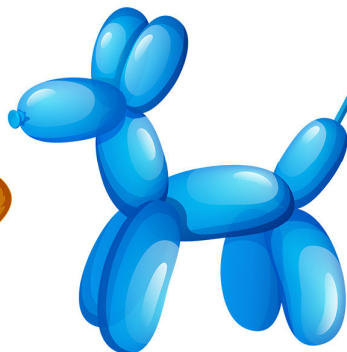
