HYBRID MEETING- The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Willey. C.M. Milanowski, C.M. Nichols, C.M. Dodd, C.M. Speer, C.M. McRoberts, Mayor Willey, Clerk/Treasurer Oster, and Marshal Svenson were present. Attorney Unzelman was absent. There were 3 citizens present.

A motion was made by C.M. Milanowski and seconded by C.M. Nichols to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Dodd and seconded by C.M. Speer to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Speer and seconded by C.M. Nichols to approve Blanket Voucher #202408 for Claim #'s 21560, 21564-21581 in the amount of \$13,950.08 and Payroll #'s 21561-21563 for a Payroll amount of \$2,150.00 for a Grand Total of \$16,100.08. Motion passed unanimously.

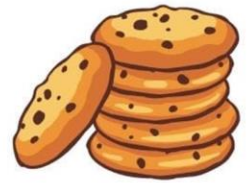

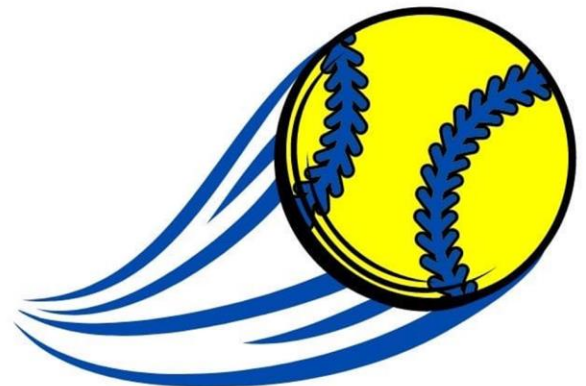
