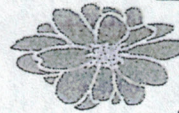

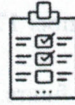



With the arrival of fall and freezing temps, trees are beginning to shed their leaves creating a dangerous, slippery mess on sidewalks and roadways. Please be sure and keep the sidewalks in front of your homes clear of debris as they pose a potential hazard to cyclists and walkers and please be proactive in making sure your storm drains are kept clean. Please continue checking on your neighbors and our senior citizens and make sure they have necessary supplies such as wood, food and medicine and sidewalks and walkways cleared, when necessary.

You may have recently noticed patrol vehicles on duty in and around the community. Per our contract with the Morton Police Department, the Town of Pe Ell now has police coverage. If you have an emergency, continue calling 911 for assistance. For non-emergency issues, call dispatch at 360-740-1105.

Thank you for using the yard waste container responsibly. The container has been removed and should be available again sometime in March.

The Eastside project is progressing and will possibly be completed in another 3 weeks. I'm pleased to report the road project up to the dam is finished!

The waste water lift station grant, CDBG, should go out to bid in the next month.

The Lighted Tractor Parade is scheduled for December 17th from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Spread the word!

HYBRID MEETING- The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Willey. C.M. Nichols, C.M. Speer, C.M. Dodd, C.M. Milanowski, C.M. McRoberts, Mayor Willey, and Clerk/Treasurer Oster were present. There were 5 citizens present.

A motion was made by C.M. Milanowski and seconded by C.M. Dodd to approve the agenda with the jail bed contract amendment added. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Speer and seconded by C.M. Nichols to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Speer and seconded by C.M. Milanowski to approve Blanket Voucher #202222 for Claim #'s 20762-20763 & 20766-20779 in the amount of \$317,651.63 and Payroll #'s 20764-20765 in the amount of \$1,750.00 for a Grand Total of \$319,401.63. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Dodd and seconded by C.M. McRoberts to approve the purchase order for 100 ft roll of poly water line in the amount of \$297.55 from Cutright Supply. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Milanowski and seconded by C.M. Speer to approve the Utility Bill adjustments for Acct #1579 a refund for an overpayment on final bill in the amount of \$35.41 and Acct #1663.1 a refund for an overpayment on final bill in the amount of \$238.93. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

A motion was made by C.M. Dodd and seconded by C.M. Speer to table Ordinance #575- setting Clerk salary until the next meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by C.M. Speer and seconded by C.M. Milanowski to transfer \$36,400 from the Current Expense fund to the Street Fund. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING- The public hearing for the property tax levy was called to order at 6:04 p.m. Clerk/Treasurer Oster stated that the Town will need to request that the highest lawful levy be requested from Lewis County. C.M. Nichols asked C.M. Dodd about current values and trends in declining values signifying a recession. C.M. Dodd stated he wasn't sure and would be a guess. There were no other questions or comments. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:17 p.m.

A motion was made by C.M. Nichols and seconded by C.M. Speer to table Resolution #268- Property Tax levy and set a Special Meeting for November 22nd at 5:30 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Dodd and seconded by C.M. Milanowski to authorize the Mayor to sign the jail bed contract amendment. Motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURN

A motion was made by C.M. Nichols and seconded by C.M. Speer to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
