This is where Lent begins—but certainly not where it ends. Over the forty-day journey through the wilderness, we draw nearer to Easter Sunday, hearing the promise that God's grace can change even the grave into a fountain of new life, welling up for eternity.

At noon on Tuesday, February 21, I will be leading a Brewing Retreat in the Luther Hall kitchen, leading any who are interested in making beer. It will grow and change over the course of our Lenten journey, until it is ready to be served following the Easter Vigil on the evening of April 8.

We will also be holding mid-week meals, with study and worship. Every Wednesday in March, at noon and at 5:30 pm, we will gather for simple meals, with study focusing on the Third Article of the Apostles' creed. We often say that we believe in "the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting," and this year we will take a deep dive into what these words mean. We'll conclude each of these days with worship in the sanctuary at 7 pm, gathering in word and prayer to hear of God's life-giving grace.

May the Holy Spirit continue to work in us, as we look forward to the future with hope.


Join Worship in Person or Online



Anything still sitting on the island after <u>February 28</u>, will be donated to Blessings Abound.




