After years of planning and support from a large and diverse set of dedicated volunteers and donors throughout Central Carleton, the Town of Hartland and surrounding communities are now building its new community complex.

A lot has happened to get us here. Our community led volunteer groups have coordinated their efforts with the Town of Hartland to commission building designs, apply for federal and provincial grants, and consult with First Nations communities. Residents in neighboring LSDs have pledged their support through a property tax increase. And on April 25 this year, elected representatives of the federal and provincial governments officially announced our project to the public.

Since that announcement, our Construction Committee has hired design and engineering firms and released its first RFP. The shovels are about to break ground this summer!

Individuals and local businesses have been generous in their contributions so far, but we still need to raise around \$1 million of our \$2.5 million goal. Receiving your support now will help us offset high prices in current markets for material and labor. It will also help us to enhance key features of our complex, such as the walking track and the community room.
