As of today, we have not yet seen any confirmed cases of the novel coronavirus, or COVID-19, in the Town of Clifton. The Town of Clifton is working closely with Greenlee County and State of Arizona Health Officials to ensure we are staying vigilant and doing our best to prevent its potential spread. I encourage residents to take common sense precautions like washing and drying our hands regularly and properly, covering our mouths when we cough or sneeze and staying home if we do feel sick. The Town is also taking preventative measures that are detailed on this webpage to combat COVID-19 locally.

We understand your concern about the potential spread of COVID-19 but encourage you not to panic. All efforts to minimize potential spread within our community are being implemented. COMBATING CORONAVIRUS

The Town of Clifton is closely monitoring the national outbreak of the novel coronavirus, now known as COVID-19. The Town is working with our public health partners at the Greenlee County Health Department, the Arizona Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to ensure that the Town is following best practices for public safety and continuation of town services.

As of 03/16/2020 per CDC, in accordance with its general guidance for large events and mass gatherings, recommends that for the next 8 weeks, organizers (whether in groups or individuals) cancel or postpone in-person events that consist of 10 people or more throughout the United States as well as Governor Ducey's 03/16/2020 announcement that Arizona schools are to be shut down through March 27, the town has cancelled and or limited the following events and/or services:

- As a precaution, the Clifton Public Library will be closed through March 27, 2020
- The Census Day 2020 Celebration scheduled for April 1, 2020 has been cancelled.
- Rental of all town facilities will be suspended until further notice.
- Visitor's Center /Tourist Info Center will be closed until further notice
- We encourage our citizens who may require city services to communicate those requests by telephone vs. visiting town hall to minimize close contact.
- We further encourage our sewage customers to utilize one of the electronic payment options offered by Payment Services Network, Inc. (PSN).
- New RV Park reservations are suspended until further notice.
- Trash/rubbish service will be modified to one pickup per month.
- Magistrate Court Notices include further guidance on managing court appearances.
