VIC HALME HISTORIAN

14 May 1945, Cpl. Louis J. Hauge, Jr., leader of a machine -gun squad serving in CO. C, First Batt., First Marine Div. on Okinawa Shima, boldly took the initiative to personally annihilate two Japanese machine guns sending a hail of fire against his platoon. As he charged the first bunker he was wounded and launched a single handed grenade attack destroying it and advancing to the second bunker still tossing grenades wiped it out before being mortally wounded by Japanese snipers. He gallantly gave his life in the service of his country and the United States Marine Corps.

MARINE CORPS LEAGUE = 1049

For those of you who have forgotten, our First Commandant was Samuel Nicholas, 28 Nov 1775- Aug. 1783. At the end of the Revolutionary War. 1783 the Marines were disbanded and reestablished 12 July 1798 by President Adams and he appoints William Ward Burrows as Commandant who served till 6 March 1804. Burrows selects the present site of barracks at 8th & I, Home of the Commandant and also organizes the first Marine Band. Archibald Henderson, 5th Commandant longest continuously serving Commandant in the history of the Corps, 17 Oct 1820-6 Jan 1859. Shortest service is of Anthony Gale, 4th Commandant, 3 Mar 1819-8 Oct 1820. He eventually is court-martialed and pleads guilty to temporary insanity and leaves office in disgrace.
