CASE 18-T-0604 - APPLICATION OF DEEPWATER WIND SOUTH FORK, LLC FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF APPROXIMATELY 3.5 MILES OF SUBMARINE EXPORT CABLE FROM THE NEW YORK STATE TERRITORIAL WATERS BOUNDARY TO THE SOUTH SHORE OF THE TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON IN SUFFOLK COUNTY AND APPROXIMATELY 4.1 MILES OF TERRESTRIAL EXPORT CABLE FROM THE SOUTH SHORE OF THE TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON TO AN INTERCONNECTION FACILITY WITH AN INTERCONNECTION CABLE CONNECTING TO THE EXISTING EAST HAMPTON SUBSTATION IN THE TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON, SUFFOLK COUNTY.

NOTICE OF FILING OF A PETITION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION PLAN FOR THE SOUTH FORK EXPORT CABLE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT South Fork Wind, LLC. (“SFW”) (f/k/a Deepwater Wind South Fork, LLC), on or about April 5, 2022, will file or has filed, a proposed petition to modify the Environmental Management and Construction Plan (the “EM&CP”) for the South Fork Export Cable Project (“Project”). The Commission issued an Order granting a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Project on March 18, 2021 (the “Certificate Order”) and an Order approving the EM&CP on November 22, 2021.

PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

SFW is proposing to modify the EM&CP to use an additional property for a laydown area: 40 Tan Bark Trail (tax map parcel 143.-1-12.3) in the Town of East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York. SFW will use this additional space for worker meetings, parking, office trailers, receiving deliveries, equipment and material storage, and **water treatment operations**.
